***Special Routine Allowances: Novice - maximum of 1 routine. Intermediate - maximum of 2 routines. Advanced - maximum of 4 routines (this may include up to 3 solos and up to 2 duets/trios, not to exceed 4 routines total).

AUDITION/TEAM PHOTOSHOOT FEE

The cost to audition is \$50 total per dancer. This includes a \$25 audition fee and a \$25 team photoshoot fee which goes directly towards our annual professional team photoshoot that takes place in the fall. AUDITION DAY: SATURDAY, MAY 30, 2025

AUDITION RESULTS

Audition results will include the following criteria and will be emailed to the address you have provided.

New team members will receive results by Saturday, June 5th and may attend summer classes beginning Saturday, June 6th. **Returning team members** will receive results by Saturday, July 10th and, until this date, should attend summer classes beginning Saturday, June 6th based on their 2025-2026 team level.

1. **“STAR” OR “STELLAR” TEAM PLACEMENT** Based on age, experience, and how much you want to compete. These teams will also be split into smaller subgroups by age and level to allow for more hands-on and level-appropriate training in technique classes.
2. **“NOVICE”, “INTERMEDIATE”, or “ADVANCED” COMPETITION LEVEL** Based on technical ability, experience, and movement/performance quality - this is required to be assigned to each dancer for entry to all competitions. If you are performing a solo, this is the level at which you will compete. Placements and successes from past competition seasons are considered when determining if a dancer should “level up”; however, written evaluations from teachers will be collected and final level assignments are at the sole discretion of studio directors. In addition to technical skills, good attitude, respect for teachers, staff, and teammates, strong work ethic, and focus in class are the most important factors in a dancer's development. Competition levels are subject to change over the summer based on dancer progress and performance.

*** To give our choreographers time to plan and our dancers time to grow throughout the summer, all group routine assignments and solo/duet/trio assignments will be released mid-to-late July.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR TEAM MEMBERS

SUMMER SCHEDULE: SATURDAY, JUNE 6 - SATURDAY, AUGUST 1.

Summer classes are mandatory for all team members so long as they are in town. Team members are required to participate in classes throughout the entire year and keep up with monthly tuition payments as part of their commitment to the team.

SHOWSTOPPER NATIONALS: MONDAY, JUNE 29 - THURSDAY, JULY 9

New team members for 2026-2027, please note: while current team members are away at nationals, classes will still take place but may be adjusted due to small class sizes and the absence of dancers and teachers.

SUMMER INTENSIVES:

FALL SCHEDULE: BEGINS SATURDAY, AUGUST 8.

This is the full schedule we will follow until the end of the school year. All assigned technique classes, ballet classes, and team rehearsals are included in your monthly tuition and attendance is mandatory to maintain your team placement. You are allowed a maximum of 2 unexcused absences per semester, however, unexcused absences are prohibited the week prior to competitions and performances.
